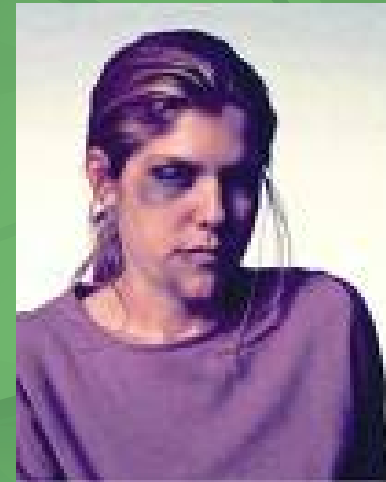
Problem: Millions of Women in Poverty

- Women make up 70% of the world's poor – almost 2 billion women living on less than \$2.50 a day
- Women in poverty cannot care for themselves or their children – 1 billion children (1 in 2) live (& die) in poverty
- The cycle of poverty perpetuates itself through “poverty mentality” – their belief in being poor
- Poverty impacts health now and for future generations
- Lack of information and resources, as well as lack of money, accelerates the downward spiral of poverty, illness and ignorance
- Money alone is not the solution to poverty



Problem: Violence against Women

- At least one in every three women, or up to 1 billion women, have been beaten, coerced into sex, or otherwise abused in their lifetimes (Research Study)
- Up to 47% of women report that their first sexual intercourse was forced (WHO)
- Up to 70% of female murder victims are killed by their male partners (WHO)
- In the USA a woman is battered, usually by her husband/partner, every 15 seconds (UN Study)
- Women at-risk also include those psychologically abused



Utilizing 21st century technology, 1000 Women.... can

- Inspire women by banishing their poverty mentality and building their self worth
- Enlighten women by showing them how technology levels the playing field creating more equality for women
- Empower women worldwide by teaching them practical, useful life and business skills – information that is easy to access, understand and apply
- Create leaders to bring peace and prosperity to the world

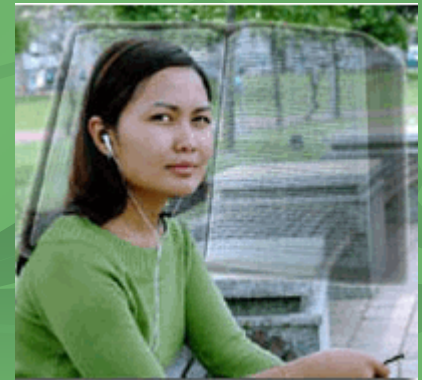

1000 Women is Changing the World with a *Virtual Program Model* That

- Is *fully scalable*, capable of being replicated in any region of the world
- Trains Team Leaders who embrace community, innovation and technology who then...
- Build Virtual Teams whose members become team leaders or Mentors who...
- Create "audio information modules" (AIM) – digital audio files that can be uploaded to MP3 players (or downloaded from the Internet)
- Delivers pre-loaded MP3 to grassroots women *anywhere*
- Obtains feedback from both women using AIM+ and team leaders with surveys



Why focus on women?

It is a well-established premise that when you benefit women, you benefit their families, their communities and beyond, because by nature women ...

- Share more information with others
- Are more nurturing and collaborative
- Reach out to help others in need – often before they help themselves
- Are consensus builders and...
- Most significantly, are peace builders.



Using Technology for Human Capacity Building

- Teleconference and VoIP (e.g. Skype) for effective communication (from local to intercontinental)
- Web 2.0 social networking for groups, forums and more
- Digital information files – primarily MP3 audio and PDF written (AIM+)
- Blogs and/or interactive websites – with password protected areas with links for digital information downloads
- MP3 players pre-loaded with life-enhancing information modules (AIM)
- Online surveys track outcomes so programs can adjusted accordingly

Women Rebuilding Africa Program (WRAP)

- Working with the Leading Women of Africa (LWA) with its pilot program in South Africa
- 1000 Women trains Team Leaders who embrace innovation and technology via Skype
- These leaders build Virtual Teams whose members become team leaders or Mentors
- These Mentors then create “audio information modules” (AIM) – digital audio files that are uploaded to MP3 players (or downloaded from the Internet)
- Through its teams, LWA then delivers pre-loaded MP3 to grassroots women in the villages and other poor areas
- LWA/1000 Women obtains feedback from both women using AIM and teams



1000 Women Expected Outcomes – In Less Than One Year

- Virtual Teams emerge in at least 10 countries in Africa – as well as Afghanistan, Latin America, Middle East and Southeast Asia
- Each team provides AIM (audio information modules to at least 50 women locally – many more with Internet)
- Each Team Leader trains at least 5 new team leaders in her area (more teams – more AIM)
- In USA, at-risk women receive AIM (plus written via Internet) through YWCA, interfaith groups and other groups working with underserved women
- Technology platform is being built to take this mission global



1000 Women Expected Outcomes – Within Three Years

- Tens of thousands of virtual teams throughout the world – each with its own infrastructure and information AIMed at the needs of the women it serves
- Hundreds of Global Community Partners (NGOs, Foundations, etc.) working with 1000 Women to create and implement more programs using AIM+
- Government agencies implementing programs using AIM+
- Technology platform completed with interactive websites, forums, directories, password protected areas for AIM+, blogs, articles, e-commerce portals for women globally to market crafts, etc.
- More women inspired, enlightened and empowered worldwide on a mission for peace for future generations

- Reduce poverty and hunger
- Improve maternal health; reduce child mortality; and combat HIV/AIDS, malaria and other diseases
- Ensure environmental sustainability
- Create more economic stability and sustainability
- Build human capacity for generations to come and

- Implement virtual team/mentor programs, such as WRAP in all parts of the world
- Build the technology platform needed to support this global system
- Retain and maintain staff, including...
 - Support staff – to enable executive staff to implement the mission
 - Data process and other technology specialists for the backend operations
 - Professional administrators to oversee and adapt the programs with changing times and technology
 - Language and culture specialists to facilitate development of materials
