Oysters with their Mother of Pearl shell cleanse the seas – just as **women create more peaceful forums** throughout the world... cleansing the world of poverty and conflict.

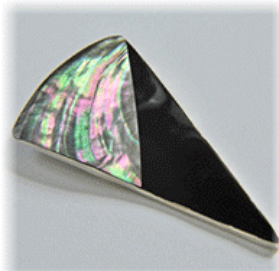
